

Theme	Blue Party
Leading Up To	Ensure that you send out invitations to your 'Blue Party' with plenty of notice to ensure that everyone invited is able to come.
What to Wear	The children and staff are to wear anything Blue today.
Decorate	Decorate the house or play areas with anything Blue. Items could include balloons, streamers, crepe paper, cellophane, blue chiffon, sheets, tablecloths, flowers, cushions, lamps, books, etc.
Food	<p>Serve blue food today!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Blue Iced biscuits, blue sprinkles, blue jelly, blue ice blocks, blue pasta, noodles or rice (add a small amount of food colouring to the cooking water), blueberries, blueberry muffins, blue angel cake, blue toffees.
Games and Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dramatic play – create your own blue world. Add blue material, blue toys, blue mats, blue cushions, blue dress-ups, or blue pictures. ▪ Art and Craft – make available blue craft resources today such as paint, glue, play dough, pictures, pencils, blue craft trolley items, or crayons. ▪ Balloon game – blow up a blue balloon and have a walking race with the balloon between your knees. ▪ Make your own blue book ▪ Matching Game – ask the children to locate blue items from around the house to place in a basket. Discuss what they have found in a group session. ▪ Remember to take photos of your Blue Day.
