



<b>Theme</b>	<b>Green Party</b>
<b>Leading Up To</b>	Ensure that you send out invitations to your 'Green Party' with plenty of notice to ensure that everyone invited is able to come.
<b>What to Wear</b>	The children and adults are to wear anything Green today.
<b>Decorate</b>	Decorate the house or play areas with anything Green. Items could include balloons, streamers, crepe paper, cellophane, green chiffon, sheets, tablecloths, flowers, cushions, lamps, books, etc.
<b>Food</b>	<p>Serve Green food today!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Green iced biscuits, green sprinkles, green jelly, green ice blocks, green pasta, noodles or rice (add a small amount of food colouring to the cooking water), green vegetables (broccoli, lettuce, peas, capsicum), green fruit (honey dew melon, green apples, grapes).</li> </ul>
<b>Games and Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Dramatic play – create your own Green world. Add green material, green toys, green mats, green cushions, green dress-ups, or green pictures.</li> <li>▪ Art and Craft – make available green craft resources today such as paint, glue, play dough, pictures, pencils, green craft trolley items, or crayons.</li> <li>▪ Make your own Green book</li> <li>▪ Group discussion – what is green at my house?</li> <li>▪ Matching Game – ask the children to locate green items from around the play area to place in a basket. Discuss what they have found in a group session.</li> <li>▪ Remember to take photos of your Green Party.</li> </ul>
