How To?	<p>Using everyday objects around the house, look for items that match (things that are the same).</p> <p>You might choose things such as colours, shapes, numbers, sizes, pairs of shoes, leaves on trees, flowers, windows, furniture, etc.</p> <p>For younger children, simply using the term ‘matching’ as you move throughout your day is a great starting point.</p> <p>Extend for older children by asking them to find things that match for themselves and point them out to you.</p> <p>Repetition is essential, so try to use the key word (matching) throughout your day to help reinforce your child’s learning.</p>
