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My Child Learns:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Creativity and design • Dramatic play
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What Do I Need?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large cardboard box • Resource box options such as: Paper plates, glue, cardboard, paint, pencils, crayons, patty cases, cellophane, masking tape, string, etc.
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How To?	<p>Starting with your cardboard box, completely remove the folding flaps from both ends.</p> <p>Punch two holes on each side of the cardboard box and thread through some string to make braces (these go over your child's shoulders). Tie the string in a knot to secure.</p> <p>Once you have your blank template, you are ready to decorate and create your vehicle.</p> <p>Use paper plates for wheels, patty cases for headlights, pipe cleaners for windscreen wipers, and then decorate your vehicle in any way you choose. Use your vehicle along side your Dress Up Box for some great Dramatic Play. Don't forget to take photos!</p>
