How To?	<p>Using everyday objects and routines, talk about what comes next. The idea of sequencing is to predict and place in order a series of events or objects.</p> <p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First we get out of bed, then we have a shower, then we eat breakfast. What do we do next? • When we set the table, I put out the placemats, then the knives and forks, what comes next? • During the day we have breakfast first, then lunch, what comes next? • The first day of the week is Sunday, then Monday, then Tuesday, then Wednesday, what's next? <p>Look for other ways to include a sequence in your day – you might include cooking, shopping, going to the park, or hanging out the washing.</p>
