<b>How To?</b>	<p>Using your pictures, ask your child to look around and find things that match.</p> <p>You may decide to base your matching criteria on colour, shape, size, or texture. For example – your child may decide to find something that is red, similar to the person in the picture’s jumper. They may choose to find someone with blonde hair at the park, the same as their picture. The more interesting your picture choice, the more things you will be able to find that match!</p> <p>To extend this activity use your pictures to create a collage with a drawn picture beside it of the matching items you found.</p>
