What Do I Need?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An assortment of interesting objects (toy car, ornament, feather, spoon, teddy, watch, etc). Note - Please make sure that you choose child-friendly items for your tray. • A shoe box • A tea towel

How To?	<p>Arrange all of your objects in the shoe box and cover with the tea towel.</p> <p>Reveal the objects to your child and let them look at and play with the objects for a short period of time. You may like to discuss the objects with your child, how they feel, what they are made of and used for. Ask your child to turn around or close their eyes. Cover the box with the tea towel. Ask your child to put their hand in the box and touch one of the objects. Ask your child if they can tell you which object it is they are touching without looking. Encourage your child to tell you how the object feels – is it smooth, rough, flat, bumpy, etc. Add or remove objects as desired to increase the difficulty of the game.</p>
