What Do I Need?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cotton Tips (or Cotton Buds) • 3 small plastic containers • Paper • Paint of your choice

How To?	<p>Painting using brushes is a good no fail way to help build your child's hand control, and is especially good as a pre-writing activity. It is also very relaxing.</p> <p>In your three containers, place three different colour paints, and put out some cotton tips to use in each.</p> <p>Encourage your child to dip the cotton tip into the paint and commence painting.</p> <p>Cotton tips do require a level of fine motor control, so don't be surprised if it takes your child a little while to get the hang of it. The cotton tips make interesting, thin line designs and are great for working with a little more detail.</p>
