<b>What Do I Need?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 8 pieces of card or A4 paper</li> <li>• Contact or laminating pouches</li> <li>• Variety of pictures from magazines – 2 of each of the same picture</li> <li>• Glue</li> <li>• Scissors</li> <li>• Ruler</li> </ul>

<b>How To?</b>	<p>Using your ruler divide each piece of paper into four and mark where you will need to cut later. Select 2 pictures the same for each set of cards. Cut out your pictures and glue them onto the card or paper.</p> <p>Clear contact or laminate your paper. Cut your laminated/contacted paper into 4. You will now have 2 sets of matching cards per piece of paper. You will have a total of 32 cards or 16 pairs. (Make more cards if you are playing with a few children).</p> <p>Prior to playing make sure you shuffle the cards. Divide them equally among the players. Players take turns to lay down their card. If the card matches the one previously laid down, shout out SNAP. Count how many matching sets each person has once all cards have been collected.</p>
