What Do I Need?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chalk • A clean area of concrete or pavement <p>Or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masking tape

How To?	<p>Draw up your Hopscotch squares using your chalk. If you do not have a concrete area, make it an inside game using masking tape to create the squares on the floor.</p> <p>Design your Hopscotch format any way you wish, with the numbers starting at the bottom and increasing as you move up through the squares. Number your squares 1-8.</p> <p>Take turns in hopping (younger children can jump instead) along through the squares, until you reach the end. Encourage your child to count out aloud as they hop.</p> <p>Start again from the beginning.</p>
