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My Child Learns:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gross motor development • Hand-eye coordination • Mathematics - counting
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What Do I Need?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bubble mix (purchase from any toy shop or supermarket, or make your own!) <p><u>Ingredients</u> 1 tablespoon of glycerine 2 tablespoons of washing up liquid 1 cup of water</p> <p><u>How To?</u> Combine all of the above ingredients in a container. Allow the mixture to stand without a lid overnight. The bubble mixture will keep in an airtight container for 2-3 weeks.</p>
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How To?	<p>Blow the bubbles for your child outside or in a clear room in the house. Encourage your child to attempt to catch the bubbles as they float past. Talk about using different body parts (such as your fingers, or your nose) to make the bubbles pop. Count how many you have popped, or how many are coming out as you go!</p>
